
Cheers to P.6 - Let's Make Secondary School Awesome!



A month ago, we had a leadership camp, it was a joyful but tiring camp.




At night, we chatted for a long time. When we finally fell asleep, it was already 12:30 a.m.



On Monday, I am going to review the WS, practise spelling the vocabulary and parts of speech. After that, I take out the grammar books to revise the tense I have learnt before.


