Last week, I and my father went to Hong Kong Seeing Eye Dog Services. It is located at Ta Kwu Ling. We went there by coach.



From this visit, I learnt a lesson that seeing eye dogs are blind people's eyes. We should love them and welcome them everywhere.








My Special Summer Holiday



Then, we went to a sushi school. We made some sushi and we also ate some tempura. It was delicious!






