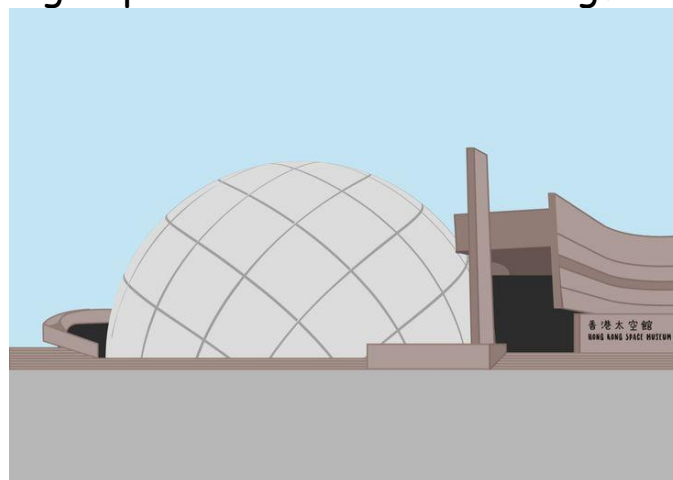
An Unforgettable Summer Holiday
